



Lafayette Chapter of Credit Unions 2017 Scholarship Information Sheet

Eligibility: **Graduating High School Seniors and Current College/Technical School Students**

To be considered for the chapter scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be a member in good standing of one of the participating credit unions
- Be graduating from high school in the spring of 2017, or currently enrolled in undergraduate studies at an accredited college, university, or technical school or with plans to attend an accredited college, university or technical school full-time in the fall of 2017
- Have maintained a 3.0 GPA based on 6 high school semesters or 1 most recent, completed college semester
- Have scored a 21 or higher on the ACT exam
- Complete an application and personal essay.

Immediate family members of current employees and Board of Directors of any of the participating credit unions **ARE NOT** eligible for the scholarship.

Application Package:

All applicants must submit an application package which includes:

- A completed application
- A current high school transcript or college transcript
- A copy of his/her official ACT or SAT results
- Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a teacher from your junior or senior year (only applies to high school seniors), or your current college professor or advisor
- A personal essay

Application Deadline:

Completed application packages must be submitted no later than January 31, 2017 to:

Incomplete or late application packages will not be considered

Selection:

Each participating credit union will review the applications they receive and forward all qualified applications to the Scholarship Committee of the Lafayette Chapter of the Louisiana Credit Union League. Only one application will be accepted from each participating member, regardless of membership at multiple participating credit unions. Final selection of the scholarship recipient will be made through a random drawing to be held at a regular Chapter meeting.

Award:

The Scholarship Committee will award a \$2,000 scholarship to the designated recipient. The recipient can use the scholarship for any school related expenses. The recipient will receive \$1,000 in August for the fall semester and another \$1,000 in January for the spring semester. The checks will be made payable directly to the recipient when proof of registration for that semester has been provided to the Scholarship Committee.

Notification:

Each applicant will be notified by mail whether or not they have been chosen as the scholarship recipient. The scholarship recipient will receive notification by March 31, 2017.
